There are a variety of reasons why students and families choose to take Driver Education either at LTHS or at a private driving school. Below is a comparision of the LTHS Driver Ed. program with that of a typical private driving school to help you make an informed decision regarding this process and help you figure out what will be the best decision for you and your family.

### **LTHS Driver Education Program**

- The program is staffed by ISBE Licensed Drivers Ed. Teachers.
- The total program cost to families is \$150.
- Any additional or make-up driving instruction is covered by the \$150 fee.
- The entire program happens during school day, eliminating conflicts after school.
- We offer a Range experience in addition to just behind the wheel instruction. This provides students with more practice on parking & maneuvering a vehicle.
- The classroom phase is taught throughout the semester, which allows students to learn concepts and then have the chance to immediately apply them.
- LT has the Co-op Program through the Secretary of State Office allowing high-achieving students the chance to waive out of the DMV road test when obtaining their license.
- LT's program averages 37 instructional hours in the classroom.

## **Typical Private Driver Education Program**

- Their staff is not required to be ISBE Licensed Teachers
- The average cost of enrolling in their program is \$525 or more.
- If students require additional driving instruction that is NOT included in the cost of the program.
- Private driving school instruction takes place after school or on weekends.
- Private driving schools do not have a Range experience and can only 6 hours of supervised driving instruction.
- Private driving schools do not offer the Co-op Program.
- Private driving school offer the minimum requirement of 30 instructional hours in the classroom.
