What is it: The Trulaske Business Academy was established in 2008 to serve as a pre-college summer program for underrepresented minority students interested in business. The goal of this residential program is to introduce students to the various disciplines and career opportunities within the business world, while also experiencing life on a college campus.

What areas are focused on: Accounting, Finance, Management and Marketing

What you would be doing:

- Interacting with faculty and staff from the Trulaske College of Business in a classroom setting
- Hands-on activities and team competitions within the lessons to help students connect the material to the real world
- Involvement in activities led by alumni and corporate partners to explore career opportunities in business
- Exposure to lessons about professionalism, team work, communication, and leadership skills
- Majority of the day is spent in classroom activities facilitated by faculty, staff, and corporate representatives
- Evenings are spent participating in social activities with Academy Coordinators and Counselors exploring the Mizzou campus and Columbia area

Who is it for: Rising 11th and 12th grade (class of 2024 and 2025) underrepresented minority students are eligible to apply for the program.

Applications: Applications are available now and students will be notified of their admission in mid-May. Applications are due by **Friday, May 4th at 4pm.**
